

## Timeline

- 1972: The timeloop begins
- April 1, 1972, Loop 1(Peewee): Peewee wakes up in Naples, Italy and adopts some babies before he intentionally falls into a coma because of a lack of G-Fuel.
- July 10, 1973: Yongki
- July 5, 1983: Researcher Ria, R5 of the current Theta Department, begins daily logs about Devona.
- May 1, 1992: In a discussion with FlowerChick rejoicing over the invention of chat clients, Wanda decides to make Tumblr, as she can't wait for Tumblr to be invented in 2007
- February 22, 1994: TBD72 and Wodin talk about fucked up baby animals
- ~~May~~April 1, 1994: TBD72 tells Wodin about the Eye Killer(This chatlog entry is listed as May 1, but comes before the other April entries, implying it to actually be April 1.)
- April 9, 1994: Wodin loses track of time researching the Killer when they were supposed to meet TBD72 at the skating park
- April 11, 1994: Wodin finds out that the latest death is a cipher saying "The Truth is Layered"
- April 21, 1994: Wodin fucks up their website
- May 2, 1994: Wodin has discovered that the Killer is leaving behind trading cards, after staying up way too late
- May 6, 1994: Wodin finds out that the Killer played a Zampanio TCG
- May 25, 1994: new body drops, which Wodin translates to "It Is Not What It Is", with a key of 13, suspecting that Eyedol Games is covering for the killer. When TBD72 wakes up, Wodin reveals that they quit their job, causing TBD72 to flip out, causing Wodin to ghost him.
- June 15, 1994: TBD72 considers enabling Wodin so they can be friends again
- August 3, 1994: TBD72 and Janey Parker talk about Wodin
- August 4, 1994: TBD72 is having trouble handling classes without Wodin
- September 12, 1994: TBD72 solves a puzzle, chats with the CEO of Eyedol, and gets a job offer
- September 15, 1994: TBD72 has an interview at Eyedol, and is creeped out by the Toms. Wanda tells JR to tell the Toms to stop being weird. JR then files a report where TP and IA complain about the Closer withholding fruit rations. Wanda also thanks J. Smith for handling Jepe. J. Smith questions Wanda's interest in TBD72
- September 17, 1994: Wanda sends TBD72 a funny animal image
- September 24, 1994: Wanda complains about the Closer sending TBD72 a fruit basket, and the Closer admits that they did it because Wanda took an interest in him, and Wanda encourages this, though says not to freak him out or cause him to quit.
- October 16, 1994: TBD72 receives a weird doll that transforms between an eye and a business woman
- November 30, 1994: Wanda warns TBD72 not to eat the cookies in the break room due to them containing peanuts, which he is allergic to, information Wanda should not have.
- December 14, 1994: Wanda convinces TBD72 to go to the Holiday Party. She also asks for a report regarding him from JR, and JR's report basically says that all is well.

- December 16, 1994: TBD72 considers quitting his job, but also learns that only he received the doll because he's his manager's favorite during the Holiday Party
- January 1, 1995: FlowerChick encourages Wanda to tell TBD72 that they accidentally faked their death, and also reveal who they really are, and Wanda promises to do so before Y2K, though also mentions that they might have really died
- February 14, 1995: TBD72 finds a guy claiming to be the CEO of Wendy's covering a room in conspiracy boards. Wanda tells the Closer about this, revealing the guy to be named "Jepe", who is attempting to get fruit, and also promote himself, and also is probably JR. Wanda tells the Closer to deal with this. The Closer does so, getting them out of the perimeter, but finds a leprechuan shipping several people including Wanda, TC, the CFO, and the Eye Killer.
- March 21, 1995: TBD72 is lost in a hedge maze for hours as a team building exercise, where he had to fight off clones and some real people for a fruit basket full of horseshoe hedgefund options
- September 12, 1995: Wanda, FlowerChick, and the Closer decide to make a Zampanio TCG which is a blatant rip-off of the not yet invented Yugioh. Then, they get a lawsuit for insider trading, since that's what using knowledge from the future looks like
- November 13, 1995: TBD72's horseshoe hedgefund options triple in price, and Wanda accidentally replies via the Wodin account. TBD72 confronts her on this, and after some time, she reveals that she was Wodin all along. TBD72 thinks this is a joke in poor taste.
- November 15, 1995: TBD72 realizes Wanda isn't lying, and says that while they can't go right back to normal, he does think they should get to know each other again, so they decide to go to lunch on Tuesday.
- November 17, 1995: TBD72 and Wanda talk about the universe being Echidna shaped, and it producing milk
- November 18, 1995: Wanda and TBD72 talk about the former's semi-omniscience
- November 21, 1995: Wanda and TBD72 go to lunch
- June 2, 1996: Wanda goes on TV to represent the Eye Killer, because it's hilarious.
- July 22, 1996: Wodin's body shows up on TV, and Wanda doesn't really find it funny, until TBD72 points out that OdinsRazor was killed by a razor. Wanda also mentions that the razor the Eye Killer uses makes it so that sometimes nobody knows until the razor gets turned off. The phrasing she uses is exactly that vague.
- January 31, 2000: Wanda decides to create the "Reverse Bang"
- May 1, 2000: Wanda turns "110010 +/- x", and FlowerChick notes that probably 0 people have made it to that age. Wanda also goes to a theme park without lines, and complains about this fact. She then comes up with a solution involving cryptocurrency, called LossPass, which she initially hosts on her website before FlowerChick tells them they have to host it on JR's website, likely resulting in Sim being appended to the name.
- August 1, 2007: Yongki begins keeping a Clown Diary, at Viktor's suggestion
- August 3, 2007: Yongki hangs out with Khana
- August 4, 2007: Yongki notices a large rat in the walls
- August 5, 2007: Khana attacks the walls in attempt to attack the rat which lives within
- August 6, 2007: Yongki goes to the upper floors and talks to Devona about the rat.
- August 8, 2007: Yongki hangs out with Devona and Khana, who don't like each other.

- August 12, 2007: Yongki begins luring the rat with food.
- August 14, 2007: Yongki names the rat Harold.
- August 18, 2007: Yongki sees Harold's hands and realizes it's not a rat.
- August 19, 2007: Yongki hears Harold speak.
- August 25, 2007: Yongki talks with Harold.
- August 26, 2007: Devona finds out about Harold, and cries, and later, Yongki beats up Devona's brother. Then, Yongki decides to leave and wait for Harold to return
- September 3, 2007: Yongki realizes that Harold isn't coming back, but decides to keep waiting regardless.
- September 11, 2007: Yongki, after losing count of days, sees Harold again, and decides to talk to it.
- September 12, 2007: The training team finds Yongki screaming about clocks and trying to dig with his fingernails, likely due to a bullet in his arm. Camille gives Yongki a new notebook, taking the Clown Diary for "research"
- December 8, 2008, 22:15: Mass power outage on the Zampanio Galactice Warpship.
- December 14, 2008: A series of events on the Zampanio Galactice Warpship
  - 21:41: An unknown guest breaks into the garden.
  - 21:42: An unknown guest causes property damage in the garden.
  - 21:43: A guest escapes.
  - 22:08-22:10: A staff member goes into Maintenance Closet B, unauthorized, and stabs a cardboard box.
  - 22:15: The staff member in the closet flips all the fuses. Power failure in the cafe as well as rooms Z and T. Guest T1 barricades door and hides in top bunk.
  - 22:20: The staff member who went in the closet leaves the closet, and then enters the wall via a vent which was not there before.
  - 21:55: A new security team is hired on the after most of the previous team quit.
  - 23:45: Guest T1 is killed by something in the walls
- April 30, 2012, Loop 1(Peewee): Peewee wakes up in the Eyedol Games HQ with a lot of debt, and meets a bunch of people and gets up to various irrelevant shenanigans.
- 2022: The world ends.

- has some sort of cursed armor/coffin situation that punishes her if she does things it doesn't like, and also makes her kill people sometimes

Parker a.k.a. Harold a.k.a. L-0-21 a.k.a. the Shot

- lives in the walls and also a cavern
- weeb
- quite powerful
- actively does not care about other people
- they fire a bullet once a day in a random direction which flies until it has caused sufficient harm
- in the 50-year timeloop
- captain of the Control team

Witherby "Wibs" a.k.a. L-0-R1 a.k.a. the Solemn

- can befriend anyone
- will not get attached

- considers himself a historian
- can lockpick
- part of the Training team
- former member of the Control team
- birthday is July 10th

Neville a.k.a. L-0-R2 a.k.a. T-R2

- transforms if Devona is hurt, slowly stalks the one who hurt her for weeks until attacking
- part of the Training team

Devona a.k.a. L-0-R4 a.k.a. T-R4

- transforms if Neville is hurt, chasing the one who hurt him for hours, causing chaos in her wake
- can remember incredibly specific details
- part of the Training team

Ria a.k.a. T-R5 a.k.a. L-0-R5 a.k.a. the Match

- if she loses hope, the world ends
- Agent
- used to date Camille
- part of the Training team
- birthday is October 4th
- frequently burns everyone alive to end a loop

Melon a.k.a. L-0-85-1

- eldest child of Peewee Cassan
- Pupated early, on April 30

Rod a.k.a. L-0-85-2

- middle child of Peewee Cassan

Rebel a.k.a. L-0-85-3

- youngest child of Peewee Cassan

The Eye Killer a.k.a. L-C-002

- a serial killer associated with Eyedol Games
- can vent
- has a razor, which, if it cuts someone, causes her to want to heal their wounds, and if they die, their body will disappear to a place where it does not undergo decomposition, and return later presumably.
- murders the same 49 people every loop
- other people can become her
- rarely speaks except through snarls and grunts
- likes eggs

Wanda a.k.a. Wodin a.k.a. L-F-001

- CEO of Eyedol Games
- pretended to be a teenager named Wodin who was friends with TBD72 and tried to track down the Eye Killer, who they believed to be associated with Eyedol Games
- knows everything between 1972 and 2022
- friends with the Eye Killer
- in the 50-year timeloop

- birthday is May 1

Peewee "the Man" Cassan a.k.a. L-U-000 a.k.a. L-C-05

- the Devil of Spirals

FlowerChick a.k.a. TT a.k.a L-U-004

- CFO of Eyedol Games
- writer of the Zampanio FAQ

the Closer a.k.a. L-W-003 a.k.a. the Wiggler Eater

- customer support at Eyedol Games
- eats fruit and children

### **Summaries(this is for important events which i cannot fit in the timeline)**

ATranscript(The Truth About Alt)

- S2 wants to merge them. S1 is flabbergasted by this idea.
- The two of them appear to be playing poker I think? Due to the clackings, and S2 randomly saying "Check."
- Snake people are showing up, and S1 suspects S2 hired one to bind them up. It is unclear what "them" refers to, but I'm guess it's the same "them" that S2 wants to merge.
- S2 actually hired the Eye Killer, who at this point has gotten caught, placing this probably in 1996 at the earliest. This(the plan, not my amazing timeline deduction) is stupid, for obvious reasons.
- S2 decides to explain from the beginning. S2 got their(maybe same them, maybe different them) kid, who tipped S2 off to his parents, and is helping S2 set an arrangement with them, during which they're(S2 and the kid's parents) obviously both planning to kill each other, so neither of them will kill the other, as if they did, the fact that the Eye Killer was involved would make the entire USA know about it.
- The Eye Killer apparently has an interest in both S2 and the kid.
- At this point, it is very clear that S1 and S2 are both members of the mafia.
- S2 wants the Eye Killer to work with them because she's clearly not human, and thus probably insanely powerful.
- S1 wants to snitch on S2's plan to the Don, so S2 gives S1 five seconds to reconsider. S1 does not reconsider, so the Eye Killer says "[One]" and presumably kills S1.

ASecondTranscript(The Truth About Alt)

- R3 has brought Viktor somewhere. There's a squelch and cracking bone, and then R3 talks, which intrigues Viktor. R3 admits that they can only talk sometimes, and asks if it scares Viktor, and Viktor explains that they're not easily scared.
- Viktor's text is red btw.
- Viktor expected R3 to babble a lot more, sense they apparently make incredibly verbose reports, and R3 explains that they write so much to compensate. They also make a joke about losing their head.
- This place is the maze, which is an anomaly outside of time managed by an AI, filled with thousands of rooms with every single kind of horror in them. People can end up here when caught by obsession, and nearly every anomaly gravitates here by 2022.

- Viktor suggests getting rid of anomalies, since they take up so much space and can cause problems, so R3 suggests they start with Viktor, and unsheaths a sword, and Viktor drops that line of argument.
- R3 wants a trade. Specifically, they want(well, "need") Viktor's voice, so Viktor can speak for them. Viktor immediately refuses. R3 assures them that it will be temporary, and that they will give something in return, but Viktor says there is nothing they want from them, and advises them to stop.
- Viktor keeps telling R3 to fuck off as they try to appeal to Viktor's emotions. R3 eventually suggests that the two of them are friends. So, Viktor rants about how they care about nothing besides their pointless mission, and keep pushing and pushing at his limits to advance it. Viktor also implies that Yongki and Khana have decided to work for R3's organization. They also vaguely imply that R3 is actually working to make the world better, and that they have just given up and don't want to be involved any more.
- R3 had thought Viktor would understand them, and is sad that they didn't, so they leave.
- Viktor realizes there's no exit, so he's trapped, so he decides to just wander.

#### AThirdTranscript(The Truth About Alt)

- Unlike other transcripts, this one has the names given, rather than using "Speaker 1" and "Speaker 2" with me having to deduce who they are. Viktor's text is red, also.
- Yongki approaches Viktor, upset. Viktor recognizes something in him. He claims that they did something to him, and demands that they fix it.
- Viktor took something from Yongki, which Yongki refers to as taking his past away. Viktor may have also done some other things. It's all very unclear since most of the details, when either of them talk about it, are replaced with repeated "â-^". Viktor says it was the price he had to pay if he wanted to stay here.
- Yongki asks what will happen if he does it again, with "it" presumably referring to whatever caused Viktor to do what they did to him. Viktor just kinda taunts him about it.
- Yongki tries to attack Viktor, but his fist stops, and he realizes he is unable to harm them.
- At this point it's pretty clear that Yongki right now is the former Captain(see NotebookSimulator), and what Viktor did at least partially involves trapping him in Yongki's body.
- The former Captain accuses Viktor of being unreasonable, and Viktor says that if they were unreasonable, they would have just gotten rid of Yongki, to not deal with this whole mess, but instead they've nurtured him for several centuries.
- Yongki additionally accuses the former Captain of just wanting them to be subservient to him.
- Viktor tells the former Captain that they're in charge, and that he should never step out of line, then tells him to get out of their sight, leading to him running into the maze.

#### TwoGayJokes(The Truth About Alt)

- Neville finds work in anomaly containment easier than what most people would expect. He finds it nice to lay out all the details for anomalies.
- At night, while other people sleep, Neville goes and wanders. This night, he's wandering in the Westerville mall, which every member of the team has wandered in before at least once.

- The mall changes, becoming an endless labyrinth, and most of the shops became minotaur/labyrinth-themed.
- He notices some things are off from how he remembers them, and even finds a new pathway behind a new ad, which allows him to find Witherby in a fancy clothes store. Neville comments that this is where Witherby hides, and Witherby is shocked by this, before noting that it's interesting that all the fancy clothes were left in here.
- Witherby steals some jewelry, and Neville is very awkward about it, initially assuming it's for a girlfriend or boyfriend, but Witherby says it's for himself. Witherby then asks Neville for his tie, and Neville obliges, and Witherby puts a necklace on him.
- Witherby continues to flirt with Neville, but Neville is oblivious. They go to steal stuff together.

#### TheTruthAboutAlt

- A woman enters a refurbished room which is Truth, but also her own handiwork. She decides to get furniture. The woman is probably unaware of the fact that this room is Truth, and almost certainly can't hear Truth talking
- The woman was apparently a copy of someone else, but didn't like being called one. The person she was copied from is now dead, and both she and Truth miss her. Specifically, she copied her appearance, and Truth notes that the two of them are nothing alike.
- She fist bumps(well she "bumps her fist" but Truth says "Fist bump: acquired" so) the sofa, and Truth raises friendship level by 1.
- The woman looks at a plank of wood, realizes it's a person, and turns into a plank of wood. This is concerning. As she tries to solve this problem, she ends up fused with the room, and eventually is able to see Truth, as well as the red text.

#### APersonalTranscript(A Censored Transcript)

- this is just the L-O-R4 Daily Logs, but without the third entry, which does not seem to be in continuity with the others, so I guess that makes sense.

#### ASecondPersonalTranscript(A Censored Transcript)

- it's day 46, I don't know what it's day 46 of though.
- Ria is investigating a part of the Infinite Parking Lot known as the Music Room.
- In here is an anomaly comprised of two women with a trumpet and a piano. They are called Lee and Hunter, or Lee Hunter collectively.
- Ria has some questions for them, and Lee Hunter forgets that Ria isn't a part of them. The two of them are fully connected, and they got confused because Ria is very open.
- The two of them come from far deeper, and were previously Central Command, but now the rest of their team and their captain are dead. There were others with them, but they were ungrateful, selfish, and didn't want to join the hivemind, so Lee Hunter left them behind.
- Ria says that one of the others killed one of theirs, and that they'll vouch for Lee Hunter.
- An ant-haired guy came in the other day, and tried to steal Lee Hunter's instruments, but he was humming a song, which got stuck in their head, and they want to hear it again because it was very good, and they'll forgive him if he plays the song. Ria agrees to let him know.

#### ACensoredTranscript



- Viktor has asked something of Parker, and thinks Parker now has it. Parker wants Viktor to go first. Viktor gives Parker a paper bag containing a "Chinatsu Yoshikawa" Nendoroid, and some water, as a courtes.(presumably a typo for courtesy?) Oh I should also note that Viktor's text color switches between Red, Black, and Void(only accessible via inspect element).
- Parker is incredibly excited by this offering. In exchange, he causes a coffin to rise up from the ground, containing a bound man with muffled screams. Viktor interprets this as a joke, but Parker encourages them to just eat "it".
- What happens next is redacted.
- Viktor's text color is normal now. Parker comments on the event, attempting to describe it. The description is censored, and causes Viktor to retch. Viktor does seem surprised that Parker was able to recall it, and Parker comments that he(presumably the bound man) didn't matter to him.
- Viktor is not doing good.
- Viktor tells Parker to "come out of the hole" more, but Parker says he can't intervene because it would "ruin the isekai". Viktor notes that Parker is already intervening by talking to them, but Parker notes that Viktor is paying him, and that if he stopped showing up, Viktor would just turn into a monster, which they'll do anyways. In the end, Parker is just an object by witch the person does something. Viktor concedes the argument.
- Viktor still laments Parker and his team not showing up more, as they could handle the situation far easier. Parker reveals that his team is all dead, as Gun made him do so back at the corporation. It's too long ago for Parker to remember though, so he doesn't care.
- Parker notes that Viktor is like an egg to him, which Viktor takes as an insult.
- Parker explains that too many things were tying him down, which was why he was stuck in "that universe", but every time he left, something left him, letting him slowly hatch, becoming some sort of perfect untethered being.
- Parker notes that Viktor is very tied to other things, such as others, and the company. Viktor says that there is very little of them, and Parker agrees, saying that they fill that absence with other things.
- Parker does think that Viktor is getting very close to getting this untethered enlightenment, and notes that this idea is the opposite of that chick with the pigtails, who Viktor refers to as R5, who cares, and has decided that the world has to be different.
- Viktor notes that Parker seems to be going through a lot, and is in a different situation than the others.
- Parker wants to ask for a hug, but notes that he smells like shit. Viktor says something, but it's redacted, saying that they're on the same filth wavelength, so the two hug.
- Parker notes that he'd kill Viktor if they paid him, and Viktor responds by saying that they'd kill Parker if he got out of hand, so they both decide that they're even.

#### Notebook Simulator

- Yongki is talking with the former Captain of the Information team about Viktor. The two of them share a body, and the former Captain has to pay rent to Yongki by way of

answering all of his questions. They switch bodies by looking in a mirror, and talk by writing in a notebook using different pens.

- Yongki asks what Viktor was like "before", and apparently the former Captain knew Viktor before the accident, and after the accident, the former Captain gave Viktor's life purpose again, but now they think that Viktor is just wallowing in uselessness. They ask Yongki if Viktor really tortures people. Yongki says that Viktor only tortures people who deserve it, and Parker makes sure of that.
- The former Captain is hurt by this statement, as they were hurt by Viktor, but don't think they deserve it. They break their pen in frustration, due to Yongki's body apparently having super-strength. Exact details about what they did and what Viktor did to them are replaced with repeated "â-^"
- Apparently, prior to the former Captain's involvement, the others would have to get to know a new Yongki every few weeks or so, whereas now there's just the two of them.
- The former Captain apologizes for breaking the pen, says they're not angry and Yongki, says that they don't feel like they deserve to be hurt by Viktor, as they were once Viktor's teacher, or maybe friend. They then say they should change topics.
- Yongki is disgusted by the former Captain making banana-flavored slime. The former Captain explains that if they make it smell good, Yongki eats it, so he needs to stop eating it if he wants it to smell good.
- Yongki explains that he now knows that they don't taste like they smell, but does say that he doesn't know why the Captain made them look like desserts. So, the Captain agrees to make them mango for a week, and then switch to orange.
- The former Captain asks why Yongki hasn't left the room when it has been his turn since the former Captain confronted Viktor.
- The scented slime is gathered and mixed on the desk, and apparently helps loosen up their body.
- Yongki explains that he didn't realize that Viktor saw him as a burden, and thought he was the memory of the former Captain. Furthermore, he doesn't like how Viktor and Khana are mean to the former Captain, even though they know that Yongki is watching, and when doing so, they also say mean things about Yongki. He's also afraid of talking to the Doctor about this, since he's afraid she will say he's a burden too. The former Captain says that she won't say that, and encourages him to seek out help from her.

#### BulletproofTheory

- Everyone has a theory for why Viktor is like that, which they each believe to be bulletproof.
- Khana thinks that Viktor is bitter due to all of their injuries, but in reality, the injuries aren't a big deal to them.
- The Captain thinks that Viktor feels isolated due to their curse, but in reality, if they didn't have responsibilities to their team they would just give into their curse and become a mindless monster.
- The other members of the Training Team each have their own theories. The short one with bouncy hair(Devona?) only discusses their theories in private. The one in the suit(Witherby?) tried asking Viktor, which was a futile attempt. The blond one(Devona's

brother I forgot the name of? Wouldn't he have the same hair color as her?) doesn't even notice anything is wrong with them.

- The only one to guess it right is a rambling addict with conspiracy walls(Ria apparently), who only got it right because she's been there. They're both weighed down by the burden of knowledge.
- Specifically, Viktor is weighed down by the knowledge of who Yongki used to be, and the debt they feel like they owe to him. They don't want to bring the Captain back(speaking of which, why was the Captain mentioned earlier, if Viktor's behavior was caused by him stopping being the Captain? Or was that referring to Yongki?), as that would be killing Yongki, but they are still trying their best to help Yongki because of him.
- Viktor will likely fuck off and become a monster once their team has moved on.

#### Two Gay Jokes / a(n un)sent letter

- This is an apology letter to Ria, from Camille. She's apologizing for breaking up quietly with her, before the fifty year timeloop began, and admitting that she still loves her, if not quite as much, especially since their relationship is currently that of Agent and Captain, which is why they can't exactly start dating again. So, this letter is to give their relationship the closure it never got.

- For some reason I'm not allowed to highlight text on this page.
- Anyways attached is an incredibly formal and well-researched report with cited sources to help Neville discover if he's bi. For some reason, like half of it is blacked out, resulting in what is presumably slight changes to its meaning. This is hilarious.
- There's literally no useful information in this one but it is so funny.

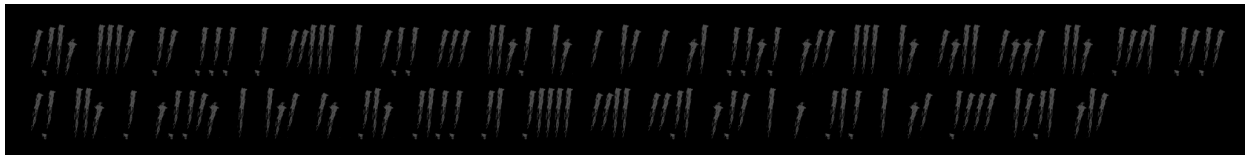
